JULIO FERNANDEZ is Vice-Rector at Universidad ORT Uruguay, where he has worked full-time since 1994 in administrative and academic positions. He became a full member of the National Academy of Engineering of Uruguay in 2001 and was elected President of the Academy in May 2019. Before his career in ORT, Mr. Fernández had been Manager of Consulting in Deloitte (Montevideo office) and Refinery Planning Manager in the national petroleum company, ANCAP. He serves in committees of ANII (Uruguayan National Research Agency) for evaluation of research projects, and is a current director of the Digital Certification Unit board of AGESIC.

Mr. Fernández holds degrees in Chemical Engineering and Computer Science from Universidad de la República (Uruguay), and a M.Sc. degree from Massachusetts Institute of Technology (U.S.A.).
