He is a Civil Aviator pilot.

He worked at UTE (Uruguayan Electricity Company) between 1979 and 2015 in the Generation Area.

Between 1993 and 2015 he was Generation Manager. In this position he had a leading role in the introduction of Wind Energy in Uruguay.

Between 2012 and 2016 he was International Generation Coordinator at the Regional Electricity Integration Commission (CIER).
